

SOUTH MARKETGAIT REALIGNMENT

THE NEXT phase of work in the multi-million pound transformation of Dundee's Central Waterfront will see South Marketgait re-aligned at its junction with Commercial Street

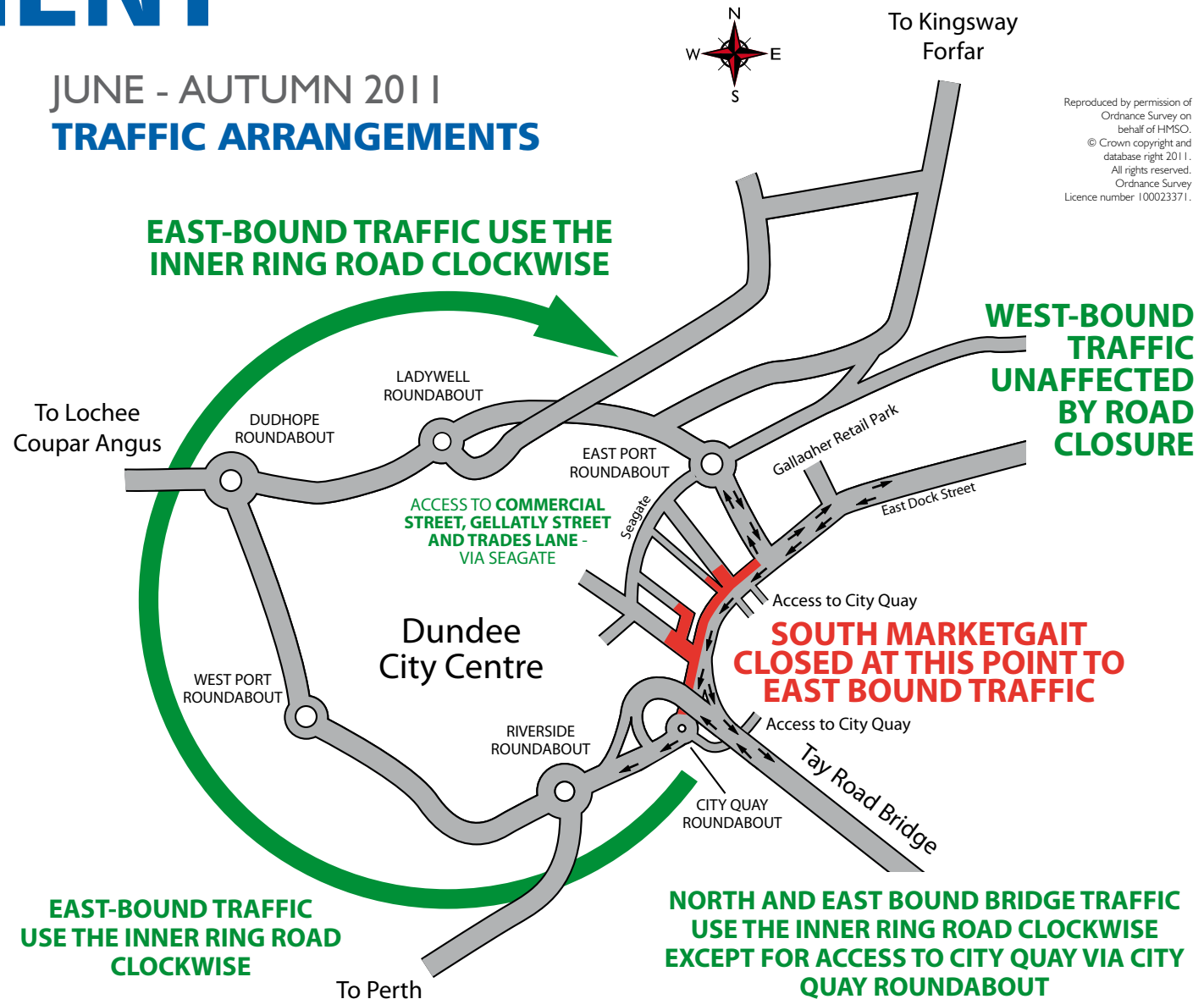
Work costing around £500,000 is expected to start in June and be completed in autumn 2011.

The city will be open for business as usual during this important and high profile stage of work that is fundamental to delivering the waterfront vision.

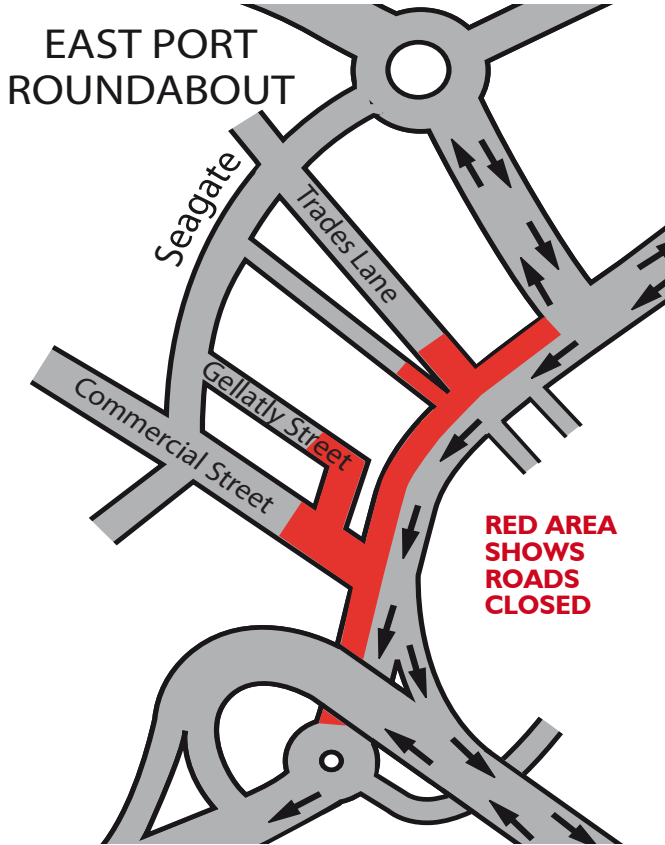
Dundee City Council, its partners and the contractor have carefully planned the work to minimise disruption, but the crucial work will also need the co-operation and patience of drivers and local businesses and residents.

To ensure the safety of the public and workforce while construction is taking place South Marketgait will be closed to eastbound traffic at City Quay roundabout. Drivers travelling in this direction at this location will be diverted via the Inner Ring Road.

JUNE - AUTUMN 2011 TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS



Any vehicle seeking access to Commercial Street, Gellatly Street, Trades Lane and Dock Street will be encouraged to use Seagate. A plan of the proposed routes and diversions is also included for your information.



It is anticipated that at peak times there will be some disruption and delays to road users as a result of the works. However, we are working in partnership with our contractor and local stakeholders in order to carefully plan and construct the project in the shortest time possible.

The multi million pound transformation of Dundee Waterfront, funded by Dundee City Council, Scottish Enterprise and the Scottish Government will further reinvigorate the city as an ideal destination to live, work and visit.

The project is one of the most notable and forward-thinking in Scotland today and although a long term scheme, already the landscape of the city is beginning to change and the renewed relationship with the river is evolving.

It is one of the key reasons that the V&A decided to come to the city and the V&A@Dundee is now an important element of the Waterfront Project.
