

New Right Turn at Waterfront Junction

DRIVERS heading for Perth from Dundee's South Marketgait will turn right at a new light controlled junction opening on Friday (January 9).

The lights, in front of Malmaison will replace the temporary right turn at Dundee Railway Station.

The pedestrian crossing from Union Street to the Railway Station will not be affected by this change.

Closure of the existing temporary right turn to Perth will allow contractors, Sir Robert McAlpine, to focus on construction elsewhere at the site including the new public open space and adjacent side roads.

Work on the £11m grid pattern of streets at the central waterfront is due to be completed by the end of 2015.
