WATERFRONT JUNCTIONS SURFACED

A NUMBER of junctions at Dundee Waterfront are set to be surfaced as part of the latest programme of works in the area.

All of the works, focussed on South Union Street will take place off peak and any road closures will be implemented overnight to minimise disruption.

South Union Street northbound to South Marketgait westbound Greenmarket car park will be closed between 7pm and 6am on both Wednesday (June 24) and Thursday (June 25).

Drivers using these routes will be diverted via the inner ring road. Access to the Railway Station lay-by at Riverside Drive will be maintained during the closure and the taxi rank will remain open.

At the same time Union Street at its south junction with Whitehall Crescent and Yeaman Shore will also be closed for surfacing and road marking work. Drivers using South Union Street northbound and Whitehall Crescent westbound routes will be diverted via Whitehall Street. On street parking will be suspended in Whitehall Crescent during these works.

Editors Notes

Dundee Waterfront is a £1 billion award-winning regeneration project that is transforming 240 acres of land along 8km of the River Tay. Dundee Waterfront is split into 5 distinct zones and is now well past the halfway mark, with over £500m of committed investment. Most of the major infrastructure works – roads, utilities, demolition, landscaping – have been completed and the 'build' phase is well underway with a growing community of businesses and residents moving into the Waterfront area. Investors, developers, entrepreneurs and financiers are responding to calls for businesses to invest in the city and capitalise on £1 billion of tourism spending forecast during the next ten years. The Waterfront skyline will change with the construction of a new railway station, V&A Museum of Design Dundee, a new marina, port developments, offices, hotels, bars, shops, cafes and residential accommodation. Around 7000 new jobs will be created, providing a wide range of new opportunities for young people seeking training and employment.
