## **WATERFRONT LANE CLOSURE**

DRIVERS USING part of Dundee Waterfront are being asked for their patience while a land is closed for essential building works.

The west (Perth) bound inside lane of Riverside Esplanade will be closed until the new year while external cladding and landscaping works take place at the V&A Museum of Design Dundee.

Drivers using the west bound off ramp at the Tay Road Bridge will also find the inside lane closed.

The closure will affect drivers between April 3 and August 4 and then again from September 25 to the end of the year.

Signs warning of the lane closure will be displayed at the south end of the Tay Road Bridge, and on other approaches to the area.

NOTE TO NEWS EDITORS: Dundee Waterfront is an award-winning £1 billion regeneration project that is transforming 240 acres of land along 8km of the River Tay. Dundee Waterfront is split into 5 distinct zones and the project has secured £750m of committed investment. Most infrastructure works have been completed and the 'build' phase is well underway, with a growing community of businesses and residents moving into the Waterfront area. More than 150,000 sq metres of 'shovel-ready' land is available for development. Major current projects include the construction of a new railway station, V&A Museum of Design Dundee, a new marina, port developments, offices, hotels, bars, shops, cafes and residential accommodation. Around 7000 new jobs will be created, providing a wide range of new opportunities for young people. Dundee is the UK's only UNESCO City of Design. Dundee Waterfront is a partnership between Dundee City Council and Scottish Enterprise.
