

## Surfacing works at Dundee Waterfront

WORK on new and replacement road surfaces on a number of main routes at Dundee Waterfront is set to start at the weekend.

The work, which will involve weekend closures at off peak hours, will create new road surfaces at junctions leading to the new grid pattern of streets in the area.

Riverside Drive eastbound from the mini roundabout at Tesco service access to the junction of Yeaman Shore/Greenmarket car park will close between 11pm and 6am on both Friday (April 24) and Saturday (April 25).

Drivers using Riverside roundabout heading east or to gain access to the Tay Road Bridge will be diverted via the inner ring road. Controlled access to the Railway Station lay-by at Riverside Drive will be maintained via Riverside Drive during the closure and the taxi rank will remain operational.

The Tay Road Bridge westbound off ramp and a stretch of road between Customs House at East Dock Street and Riverside Drive mini roundabout at the service access to Tesco will be closed on Friday May 8 between 7pm and 6am and Saturday May 9 between 7pm and 6am.

This will allow surfacing and road markings to be put down on the westbound section of the new junction between Riverside Esplanade and Riverside Drive.

Drivers using the Tay Road Bridge westbound off ramp and Riverside Esplanade heading for Perth will be diverted via the inner ring road. Access to Discovery Point and Premier Inn from Riverside Drive will be maintained during the closure and access to the railway station is also unaffected.

To minimise disruption a stretch of East Dock Street westbound from Customs House to Riverside Esplanade will also be resurfaced at the same time.

Work is expected to be completed by the end of May.

First Closure - 2 nights on Friday 24th April 2015 and Saturday the 25th April between 11.00pm and 6.00am



Second Closure - 2 nights on Friday 8th May 2015 & Saturday the 9th May between 7.00pm and 6.00am
